- 1922** – Alpha Wire begins as a supplier of wire strengtheners to the millinery (women's hats) industry.
- 1930s** – The company becomes a valued supplier to the radio industry, producing wire and insulators for antennas.
- 1940s** – Alpha Wire supplies the U.S. defense industry during World War II with wire for electronics equipment used to win the war.
- 1950s** – Capitalizing on the growing popularity of television, the company provides wire to manufacturers of television sets.
- 1960s-1990s** – Alpha Wire expands its portfolio of products to include the introduction of superior flex capabilities.
- 2000s** – The company develops EcoWire®, the industry's first smaller, lighter, and zero-halogen hook-up wire.
- 2010s** – Alpha Wire acquires COAST to expand its capabilities to include custom cables.
